## The Girlguiding UK Centenary Camp

In 2010 we look forward to celebrating 100 years of guiding with Guides and Girl Scouts from all across the world.

Girlguiding UK would like to invite members of WAGGGS and the Girlguiding UK Branch Associations to the Girlguiding UK Centenary Camp to be held at Harewood House, Leeds.

Harewood House, with historical links to guiding, is the home of the Earl of Harewood, cousin of HRH Queen Elizabeth II and the son of HRH Princess Mary, The Princess Royal, Countess of Harewood and the President of The Girl Guide Association (1920-1965).

The camp will commence on Saturday, 31 July, and end the following Saturday, 7 August. Among the memorable experiences on offer is the 'Spectacular', when we will join up with 30,000 members of Girlguiding UK for a unique performance for all ages.

The cost of attending the Camp is approximately £400 (UK Sterling) per person, which will include all accommodation and camping fees, special edition Centenary Camp equipment, food, admittance to the 'Spectacular' and a full activity programme.

Groups applying need to be a minimum of four Guides/Girl Scouts aged 12-16 (at the time of the camp) to one adult (4:1 ratio), and a maximum of 12 Guides to three adults. Provision will be made for applicants with disabilities.

Harewood House is situated in Yorkshire, northern England, about two hours journey by train, or a one hour flight, from London. International visitors can arrange to be collected from either York Railway Station or Leeds Bradford Airport (LBA) for a small additional fee.

If your group would like to extend their stay in the UK after the Camp, further accommodation and travel information can be provided.

We look forward to welcoming you to the UK in 2010!
