CALL FOR CENTENARY AMBASSADORS

Would you like to play a part in shaping the centenary celebrations for WAGGGS? Do you want to be one of the first people in your Association to hear about WAGGGS' exciting plans for its three year celebrations? Do you want to make sure that the rest of WAGGGS knows about your Association's centenary celebrations?

We are calling for representatives to join our team of centenary ambassadors. Each Member Organization can nominate up to two centenary ambassadors. As an ambassador you will be the link person between WAGGGS and your National Association. Your main responsibility will be to promote our centenary activities to your National Association and to let us know what your Association plans to do at a national level. For example, we will send you information about our annual centenary celebration day on April 8 each year for you to publicise among your national members.¹

You will also play an important role in monitoring WAGGGS' centenary activities, giving feedback on some of our ideas and also participating in an annual evaluation of events.

This is an exciting opportunity to be part of an international network. You will have access to a dedicated area of the website where you can join discussions, give your feedback and where you can post what is happening in your National Association.

¹ All information will continue to be sent to the regular contact point also.

Finally, each ambassador will be presented with a certificate and a pin in recognition of their role in making the WAGGGS' centenary a success.


Criteria

Each Member Organization may submit up to two nominations. One of these should be under 25 and one should be a member of the national board. The individual does not necessarily have to be the same person who is organizing the Member Organization's centenary events. Ideally one of the candidates should be able to commit to the role for 3 years. Ambassadors should have regular access to the internet and should speak English, French or Spanish.
